- Please put LOI and the focus area you have selected in the Subject Line of your email (for example: LOI-Education or LOI-Health & Wellness).

All Letter of Inquiry submittals will be acknowledged electronically. Late submissions will not be considered

The 2020 Grant Letter of Inquiry (LOI) must be received by 5:00 p.m., Monday, February 3, 2020

IMPORTANT NOTICE: The first step in our evaluation process is to confirm that you have followed ALL of our instructions, followed our guidelines, adhered to our process, and submitted everything we requested *AS WE REQUESTED THEM*. This step is crucial as to whether or not your organization will move on in the evaluation process. Attention to detail at this stage is critical to moving on in the process.
